Points of Excellence 2021 - 2022



- » The Southeastern Channel, Southeastern Louisiana University's educational cable television station, has been honored once again as best in the nation with a first-place national award given by College Broadcasters, Inc. The channel won for Best Video Newscast for its Nov. 11, 2020 episode of "Northshore News."
- » For the tenth consecutive year, Southeastern Louisiana University has been named a Military Friendly School.
- » Southeastern Louisiana University has been admitted as a member institution for the Carnegie Project on the Education Doctorate, a consortium of over 125 institutions around the world focused on transforming the advanced preparation of educational professionals to lead through scholarly practice for the improvement of individuals and communities. Southeastern is the first and only university in Louisiana to be selected for membership in the organization.
- » Southeastern Louisiana University's Professional Sales Team won second place out of 80 universities in the World Cup of Sales at the 2022 International Collegiate Sales Competition.
- » Southeastern's Kappa Sigma chapter has been awarded a Kappa Sigma Founders' Award of Chapter Excellence as one of the fraternity's top chapters in North America.
- » Southeastern Louisiana University's undergraduate nursing program has been recognized by the Louisiana Nurses Foundation with the Nightingale Award as the Nursing School of the Year. The awards recognize the achievements of the nursing program's students and faculty. This is the fifth time Southeastern has been recognized with a Nightingale Award for the undergraduate nursing program.

- » For the 10th time, Southeastern Louisiana University's Southeastern Channel has been recognized as the "Best College Television Station in the South." The channel earned first place "Best of South" honors for the fourth year in a row and the seventh time in the past 10 years at the annual Southeast Journalist Conference. Its seven years of winning "Best College TV Station" since 2013 are the most by any university in the southeast region of the U.S. During that time, when the Southeastern Channel did not win first place, it won second place.
- » Southeastern was honored by the Louisiana Foundation against Sexual Assault (LaFASA) with the Ally of the Year award.
- » The Southeastern Louisiana University Laboratory School celebrated an improved report card. The school performance increased by 2.2 points, and the Lab School remains the only 'A' rated school in Tangipahoa Parish. Lab School Director Steven Labbe said the school's score improved from 94.3 to 96.5, which means their students grew academically even through the pandemic.
- » The student staff of The Lion's Roar, Southeastern Louisiana University's student newspaper, brought home nine awards from the annual Louisiana Press Association Better Newspaper Competition. The Lion's Roar, garnered first place in "Best New Photo" and second place accolades in the "General Excellence", "Best Front Page", and "Best News Story" categories.
