2021 - 2022 Highlights

- » Honors courses were taught in many areas in 2021-22 including: Art, Biology, Business, Chemistry, Communication, English, History, Humanities, Mathematics, Psychology, and SE 101. The average Honors course size was 15 students.
- » Sixty-four students earned Sophomore Honors Distinction for completing 15 hours of Honors courses with no grade lower than a 'B' by the end of their fourth regular semester in 2021-22. Nine students earned Senior Honors Distinction for maintaining a 3.2+ GPA and completing nine hours of upper-level Honors courses including a special topics course and thesis-reading training.



- Fifteen seniors presented their theses and earned the Honors Diploma in 2021-22. The disciplines in which the theses were completed attest to the breadth of the Honors Program. Students earned the Honors Diploma in Accounting, Art, Biology, Chemistry, General Studies-Dance, History, Kinesiology, Mathematics, Music, Nursing, and Psychology.
- Honors Graduates in 2021-22 were admitted to a number of graduate and professional schools including programs at the University of New Orleans, Master's University and Seminary, Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center, and Southeastern Louisiana University in fields ranging from the MBA to the doctorate of physical therapy. The Class of 2021-22 also secured a number of excellent job postings including registered nursing, teaching, dance instructing, and laboratory technician.
