- » Joseph Schopp (Occupational Safety, Health and Environment) was awarded a \$5,000 national scholarship from the Board of Certified Safety Professionals.
- » Grace Babin (Marketing), who won the spring 2022 Southeastern Sales Challenge, represented Southeastern at the 24th Annual National Collegiate Sales Competition in a role-play and won second place in her wild-card round.
