### **Graduate Professional Education**

Four (23.5%) of the respondents have completed a degree (two a second masters and two a doctorate degree). One (5.9%) has taken classes but not enrolled in a degree program, two (11.8%) plan on enrolling in a graduate degree program in the future and ten (58.8%) have no plans for further education. Of those with future plans, one (50.0%) plans on eventually obtaining a second masters and one (50.0%) a doctorate. Of the respondents with graduate experience, two (40.0%) felt that Southeastern "Very Effectively" prepared them for further graduate/professional and three (60.0%) indicated they were "Effectively" prepared. Of those who have earned a degree or enrolled in a program, all (100.0%) indicated the degree was "Very Closely Related" to their Master's degree.

### **Employment**

Fifteen (88.2%) of the respondents are currently employed full-time, one (5.9%) is employed part-time and satisfied with part-time work, and one (5.9%) is not employed and not looking for employment. The rest of them employment information is based on those who are employed full-time. All of the alumni (100.0%, n=15) are employed in the state of Louisiana. One (6.7%) is employed in higher education, one (6.7%) in government, one (6.7%) in private practice/self-employed, one (6.7%) in industry, and ten (66.7%) in a health agency. Five (33.3%) respondents indicated their education was "Very Effective" in preparing them for employment or improving their job performance and ten (66.7%) indicated it was "Effective". Eleven (73.3%) of the respondents are employed in the area of their Southeastern master's degree and four (26.7%) in a related area. One (6.7%) respondent indicated a salary range of \$40,001-\$50,000, one (6.7%) indicate \$60,001-\$70,000, and thirteen (86.7%) greater than \$80,000.

### **Overall Satisfaction with Southeastern**

In general, respondents were satisfied with Southeastern. Forty-one percent (41.2%, n=7) had a Very Positive general attitude toward Southeastern, and an additional 41.2% (n=7) had a Positive general attitude toward Southeastern. One (5.9%) had a Neutral attitude, and two (11.8%) had a Negative attitude. When asked if they would recommend Southeastern to a friend or family member considering graduate education, 58.8% (n=10) said they would with no reservations, 23.5% (n=4) indicated they would with some reservations, one (5.9%) would with strong reservations, and two (11.8%) probably would not.

The majority (64.7%, n=11) of the respondents indicated that if they were to do it again, they would elect to attend Southeastern for their Master's degree, two (11.8%) were not sure if they would, and four (23.4%) would not. Respondents were also asked if their college education had improved the quality of their life, regardless of the financial benefits. The majority (88.2%, n=15) of the respondents indicated that the quality of their life had improved.
