U. S. real gross domestic product grew at a 1.4 percent annual rate during the second quarter of 2016 and was 1.3 percent higher than in the second quarter of 2015.

Total civilian employment for the second quarter of 2016 rose 1.6 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year while the workforce grew by 1.0 percent. This led to a decline in the unemployment rate from 5.4 percent in 2Q2015 to 4.9 percent in 2Q2016.


A survey of professional forecasters released in August 2016 by the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia projects the U.S. economy to grow 1.5, 2.3, 2.3, and 2.2 percent in 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019, respectively.

An alternative September forecast by Wells Fargo Bank indicates gains of 1.5, 2.2, and 2.1 percent in 2016, 2017, and 2018, respectively.

Total state employment for the second quarter of 2016 increased 0.5 percent from the previous quarter but was down 0.1 percent from 2Q2015.

The statewide labor force for 2Q2016 increased by 0.8 percent from the previous quarter but fell 0.2 percent from 2Q2015.

The slight year-over-year declines in both employment and the labor force led to the unemployment rate being unchanged in 2Q2016 compared to 2Q2015 (6.3 percent).

Changes in state sales tax rates and exemptions by the 2016 Legislature led to increased sales tax collections in 2Q2016 of 49.5 percent from the prior quarter and 47.6 percent compared to 2Q2015. Although detailed analysis was not

possible, it is believed that essentially all of this increase was due to the legislation changes and not any increase in retail activity.


Seasonally-adjusted state personal income increased 1.2 percent from the first quarter of 2016 and 1.7 percent compared to 2Q2015. Year -over-year, net earnings increased 0.8 percent, dividends, interest, and rent 1.3 percent, and personal transfer receipts 4.8 percent.

Industries contributing the most year-over-year growth in earnings from 2Q2015 to 2Q2016 were *Health care and social assistance* (+\$738 million), *Construction* (+\$648 million), and *Non-durable goods manufacturing* (+\$455 million) .



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Northshore Employment


Total employment in the Northshore Region in 2Q2016 was 1.3 percent higher than in 1Q2016 and 0.3 percent lower (-763 jobs) than in the second quarter of 2015.

The total civilian work force in 2Q2016 rose by 1.5 percent from the previous quarter but fell 0.8

percent from 2Q2015.

The growth in the work force from the prior quarter led to an increase in the unemployment rate for 2Q2016 to 5.7 percent, up 0.1 percent from the previous quarter but down 0.5 percent from the 6.2 percent of 2Q2015.


EMPLOYMENT (Not seasonally adjusted)



Northshore Estimated Retail Sales

Taxable retail sales for the region in 2Q2016 averaged \$760 million per month, an increase of 2.2 percent compared to 2Q2015.

Sales tax collections were up in all Northshore parishes except Washington, which was down 15.8 percent compared to 2Q2015.



Northshore Residential Building Permits

The number of building permits for residential units in the Northshore region issued during 2Q2016 (excluding St. Helena Parish—for which data were not available) rose by 10.7 percent from the prior quarter and was 4.2 percent higher than in the second quarter of 2015.

Year-over-year changes ranged from declines of 20.8 and 14.1 percent, respectively, in Livingston and Tangipahoa parishes, to increases of 32.6 and 57.1 percent, respectively, in St. Tammany and Washington parishes.

Note that permit counts for some parishes and municipalities are based on data reported to or estimated by the U.S. Census Bureau.




There were 2,025 homes sold during 2Q2016 at an average price of \$209,342. The number sold

Livingston Parish

Livingston Parish employment in 2Q2016 was up 1.2 percent and the labor force grew by 0.8 percent compared to the second quarter of 2015. Although the unemployment rate of 5.0 percent was up from 4.8 percent in 1Q2016, it was down from the 5.4 percent of 2Q2015.

The value of taxable retail sales in 2Q2016 rose 5.7 percent compared to 2Q2015.

The number of residential building permits fell 11.6 percent from the previous quarter and 20.8 percent compared to the second quarter of 2015.

There were 493 homes sold in Livingston Parish in 2Q2016, down 6.1 percent from 2Q2015. The average selling price in 2Q2016 was \$180,821, up 3.2 percent from 2Q2015. Combined, the decrease in volume and increase in average price led to a 3.1 percent decrease in total volume.


Livingston Parish residents purchased 1,734 new cars and light trucks in 2Q2016, down 1.3 percent from the second quarter of 2015. Livingston Parish dealers sold 353 new vehicles within Louisiana, up 6.6 percent from 2Q2015.






St. Helena Parish

Employment among St. Helena Parish residents in the second quarter of 2016 fell by 2.3 percent compared to 2Q2015. The labor force declined by 4.2 percent, leading to a drop in the unemployment rate from 9.4 percent in 2Q2015 to 7.6 percent in 2Q2016.

The value of taxable retail sales within St. Helena Parish in the second quarter rose 1.8 percent compared to the second quarter of 2015.

Building permit data were not available for St. Helena Parish for 2Q2016.

There were two homes sold in St. Helena Parish in 2Q2016, with an average price of \$72,500.

Residents of St. Helena Parish purchased 56 new cars and light trucks in the second quarter of 2016, the same number as purchased in 2Q2015.



The number of employed St. Tammany Parish residents in 2Q2016 grew 0.3 percent from compared to 2Q2015 while the labor force declined by 0.2 percent, leading to a decline in the unemployment rate from 5.7 percent in 2Q2015 to 5.2 percent in 2Q2016.

The value of taxable retail sales in 2Q2016 rose 2.8 percent compared to the second quarter of 2015.

Building permits for residential units in 2Q2016 rose 32.6 percent compared to the same quar-

ter in 2015, foreshadowing strong construction activity in the coming months.

The number of homes sold in St. Tammany Parish and the average selling price were up 7.1 percent and 0.5 percent, respectively, compared to 2Q2015, leading to a 7.7 percent increase in total residential sales volume.

St. Tammany Parish residents purchased 3,807 cars and light trucks in 2Q2016, up 1.0 percent compared to 2Q2015. Parish dealers sold 3,395 vehicles throughout Louisiana.



Permits for 22 residential units were issued in 2Q2016, up 57.1 percent from 14 in 2Q2015.



GNARLY COUPLE TAPPED AS YOUNG ALUMNI OF THE YEAR

It's rather fitting that an alumni couple who are making their mark in the craft beer industry will be tapped as Southeastern Louisiana University 2016 Young Alumni of the Year.

The couple – Zac from Mandeville and Cari from Covington -- met at Southeastern as undergraduates. He was a general studies major, while Cari was studying family and consumer sciences majoring in merchandising with a minor in marketing. They married in 2009 and now have a one-year-old daughter named Stevie.

What started as a home-based hobby in their garage became a passion for crafting small batches of beer that received rave reviews at area festivals. That passion led to the formation of a corporation in 2011.

They both knew they wanted Hammond – home of Southeastern and a really cool skate park downtown – to also be home to their brewing company. In Spring 2014, the Caramontas opened Gnarly Barley Brewing Company in the heart of Hammond with the release of their first beers from a 10,500 square foot location on Corbin Road.

Gnarly Barley now produces three flagship beers and two specialty beers, which are distributed at approximately 300 locations throughout nine parishes. The company plans to start offering the product in cans in time for Mardi Gras next year.

A new business created to be a part of a fast growing industry resulted from the will of two entrepreneurs that knew success was attainable – and it all started with two Southeastern students passing each other in White Hall between classes.
