A. Bill FA21-10 Financial Bill to sponsor food for International Night for the Department of Languages and Communication

Sen Watson: This is a bill to sponsor catering food for International Night, this is a generally large event of usually about 250-300 people; the department is requesting maximum amount of \$1500 for expenses

Representative: this is a kickoff event for a week-long celebration during International Education Week; the event serves to celebrate international students, it will be fun for students to participate, enjoy performances, eat at the buffet, celebrate our international students, showcase cultures, and come together as student body. It is important to let international students know we are invested in them. There will be a show consisting of dance, poetry, music and other performances. Try to select unique, multicultural foods that students are not familiar with.

Sen. Guilbeau: Would it be possible to develop an RSVP system to ensure the estimate of attendees is correct in order to ensure adequate funding?

Representative: This is also an event open to the overall community, so the exact number is difficult to get. The estimated amount is already lowered from what we have seen in past years: have had attendees sign in at previous events, usually at least 200-300, but we expect the actual number to be way bigger- closer to 400. Investment in advertising- flyer with SGA logo on it posted around, sent out to all dept. heads, coaches- many international students are athletes so informing coaches worked well before especially with getting excused from sporting events, word-to-mouth to community.

Representative: On campus in the Student Union Ballroom
